INSTALL



Follow the instructions in the table below to install the Content by Type Web Part to your SharePoint environment. After deploying the following files have been copied to your SharePoint server(s):

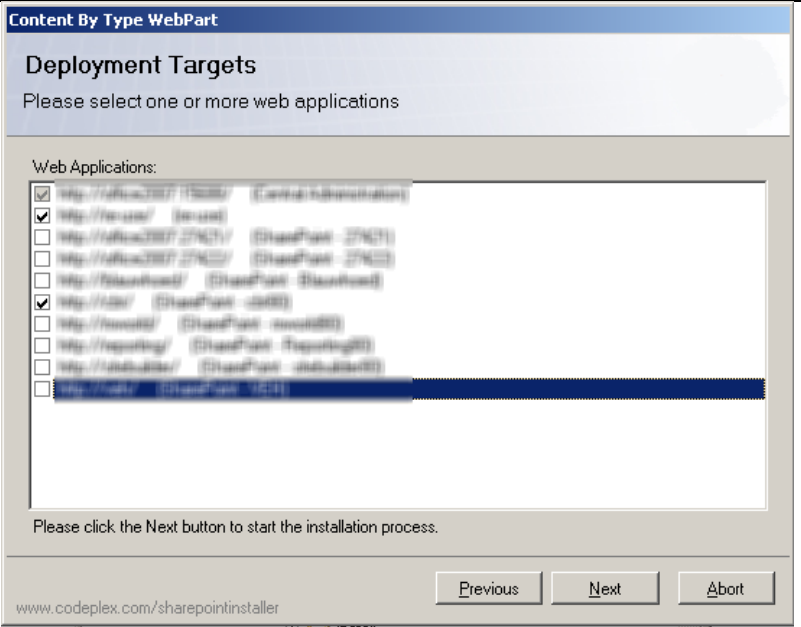
Follow the steps below to install the Content By Type WebPart version 1.2 to a new environment.

Please note: If you have a farm with multiple front end server, you just need to follow these step on 1 of the front end servers.

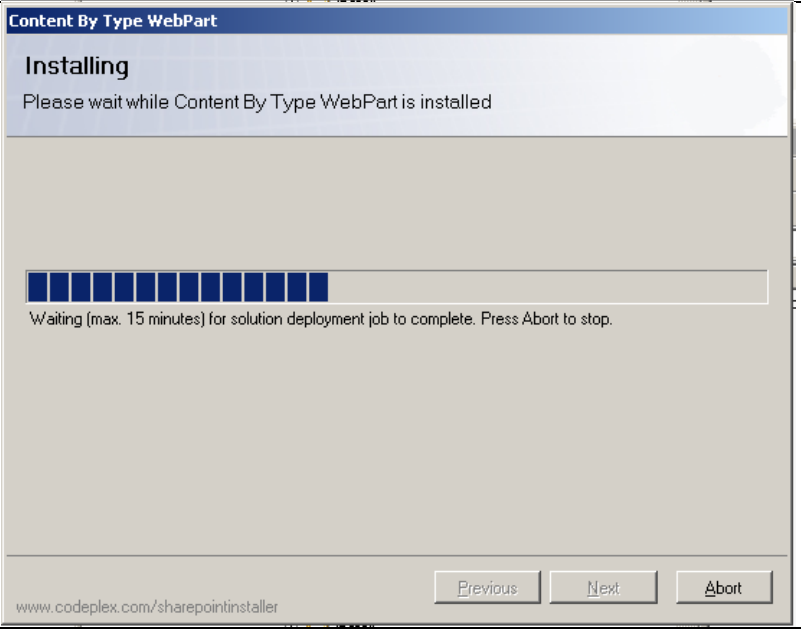
1	Copy the file "TST.WebParts_1.2_Build20080410.zip" to your SharePoint server. Please note: the last of the filename is the buildnumber and can be different	
2	Unzip the file to a folder on your SharePoint server	The folder should contain these files after unpacking: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Setup.exe• Setup.exe.config• TST.WebParts_1.2.wsp

3	Start Setup.exe	
4	After clicking Next the installer will do a number of checks and prepare the installation	

5 In the next screen, select the web application to which you want to deploy the webpart

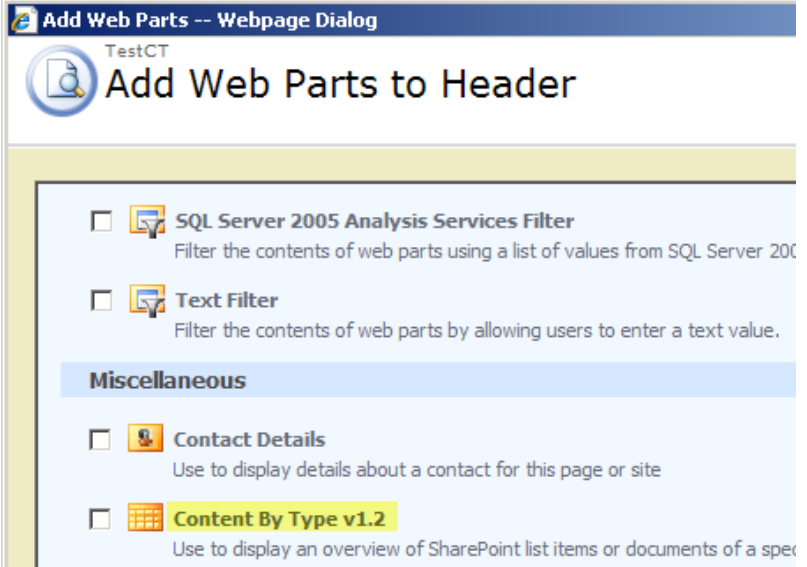


6 Click Next to start the installation.



Close the wizard. Your webpart is now ready to be used in all sites in this site collection. In the “Add Web Parts” dialog, it should show up in the “Miscellaneous” section.





UNINSTALL

By following the steps below you can uninstall the Content by Type from your SharePoint environment. Please note that this process only uninstalls the webpart. It does not remove the webparts from the pages. You will have to do this manually.





Please note: the paragraph following this, contains the instructions to uninstall the webpart without using the Solution Installer.



4	Click Next start the retraction of the webpart. Click Next once more to get a summary of the uninstall process. You webpart is now uninstalled.	
8	Delete the ZIP file and its content from your SharePoint server (these file was copied in step 1 of the installation guide).	
9	The Content by Type webpart is now removed from your SharePoint server(s)	

UNINSTALL - MANUALLY

By following the steps below you can uninstall the Content by Type from your SharePoint environment. Please note that this process only uninstalls the webpart. It does not remove the webparts from the pages. You will have to do this manually. The screenshots are based on version 1.1, but they apply to later versions as well.

1	Start SharePoint Central Administration and navigate to the Operations tab.	
2	Click Solution Management in the Global Configuration section.	 <p>Global Configuration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▫ Timer job status ▫ Timer job definitions ▫ Alternate access mappings ▫ Manage Farm Features ▫ Solution management
3	Find “TST.WebParts.vX.X.wsp” in the list and click on the name.	 <p>tst.webparts.v1.1.wsp</p>

5	Select “All content Web applications” and click OK. 6	After some time (make sure the Windows SharePoint Services Timer service is running) the status of the wsp changes from “Retracting Scheduled” to “Retracting” to “Not Deployed”.	

7	Click on the wsp package name in the overview and select "Remove Solution".	
8	Delete the ZIP file and its content from your SharePoint server (these file was copied in step 1 of the installation guide).	
9	The Content by Type webpart is now removed from your SharePoint server(s)
